Products within the liferaft portfolio are designed and maintained to the highest standards, drawing on Survitec's many years of experience as an industry leader in lifesaving appliances. Throughout the design phase our highly experienced team works to clearly defined objectives actioned in a strict project management process to ensure that a functional and reliable design is achieved.

TRIED AND TESTED

Liferafts are then created as prototypes and extensively tested to the SOLAS requirements of MSC 81(70) as well as other relevant standards. This involves thorough testing of the material choices, construction techniques and also the performance of the products in real-life test scenarios. This ensures the design is fit for purpose in severe marine environments.

INDUSTRY APPROVALS & STANDARDS

Once a liferaft design successfully passes the required approval trials, the products enter a rigorous process to obtain approval from worldwide class and flag societies. Survitec holds ISO9001, MED Mod B & D and AS9100 aviation standard certification.



Cross-functional reviews are built into the manufacturing process providing opportunities to ensure we deliver on quality.

QUALITY & ASSURANCE

The robust quality processes set by Survitec ensures that material strength specifications are met. Joints are designed in shear rather than peel - improving strength and extensive testing is conducted at all stages. To ensure end-to-end product quality and consistency, we carefully monitor the manufacturing process throughout with highly skilled internal and external independent teams.

STRICT MANUFACTURING PROCESSES

Manufacturing follows well documented processes with standard operating procedures, in-stage inspection qualification checks and pressure testing of final product in place, ensuring compliancy to the required documented SOLAS specifications.

Deployment of liferafts at Survitec are then carried out to ensure they perform as intended if and when required in an emergency situation.

CONSISTENT SERVICING LEVELS

To consistently deliver high service levels to our customers, all Survitec approved service stations are audited and approved to the highest legislative and regulatory standards. Only approved and trained service engineers are authorised to carry out the work required on Survitec liferafts. These consistent service levels are maintained across over 405 service stations globally serving 2,000 ports.

PACKED AND STOWED WITH CARE

To ensure our liferafts can perform as intended when called upon, they undergo a strict packing process involving a buddy system to check certain critical steps.

Liferafts designed to be stored on ships' decks will be packed in a tough glass reinforced plastic container to shield them from the elements and also to protect from potential impacts during a deployment at sea.



A CENTURY OF BEING BUOYANT IN SURVIVAL



Survitec's roots trace back over a century with 2020 marking 100 years since the introduction of inflatable survival technology. Our fascinating story starts some years later in 1920, when Reginald Foster Dagnall, an experienced balloonist and airship pilot, put his engineering flair and innovative thinking to work founding RFD (now known as Survitec).

In its early years, the company manufactured lightweight doughnut inflatable rings designed to be stowed centrally over an aeroplane cockpit, which on ditching the aircraft were manually inflated by aircrew. This simple invention stopped the aircraft from sinking, suspending it under water until it was salvaged. This initial product evolved when a floor was added, doubling up the doughnut system as rescue accommodation for aircrew.


In 1932, a method of automatic inflation was introduced, which signalled a major breakthrough for the company, revolutionising the industry for years to come. This new design was operationally tested in 1933 during aircraft ditching trials and subsequently adopted by the Air Ministry for extensive use throughout World War 2.

Slowly but surely, the recognition for the requirement of liferafts on commercial and military vessels grew, with navies across the world soon carrying RFD liferafts. In 1956, the carriage of inflatable liferafts became mandatory for all fishing vessels.

Fast forwarding to 1965, liferafts became mandatory under SOLAS, and RFD was honoured in becoming the first approved by the regulations. Over time we have developed our liferafts to meet the ever changing markets.
